

Case Study Havas

3 Pancras Square, Kings Cross, London Architect: MCM Architecture Ltd Main Contractor: **Structure Tone**

When Havas, one of the world's leading global communications groups, chose to consolidate 1700 employees across seven London locations into one new 10 storey headquarters building in King's Cross, the design had to be reflective of a modern creative business and one that would spark creativity and collaboration across a number of disciplines.

Central to the inspirational fit-out of this landmark 'vertical village' was the seamless integration of bespoke partition systems from leading designer and manufacturer of glass partitioning systems, Optima.

For what was an intricate and complex project delivered under a very tight programme, Optima worked with architect MCM and main contractor Structuretone to create office and breakout spaces, meeting rooms and a central auditorium where acoustic performance, design aesthetics and the seamless integration of glass partitioning was paramount.

A stunning feature of the auditorium, used to host company events and large company meetings, are the Shoreditch Edition pocket sliding doors within Revolution 100 double glazing, along with pivoting glass doors.

All of the Shoreditch Edition glazing incorporates the architect's non-uniform 'Mondrian' pattern which brings a unique industrial warehouse feel to this contemporary workspace. The design meant that attention to detail and precision on site was critical. Optima's design expertise and ability to deliver on-site proved key to the project's successful completion.



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Visually & technically impressive:

Havas's new King's Cross headquarters is an impressive 165,000 sq ft building with exquisite design features. The project involved delivery of a unique, non-uniform 'Mondrian' patterns to the glass screens and doors, and bespoke glazing joints.
